



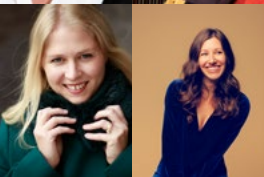

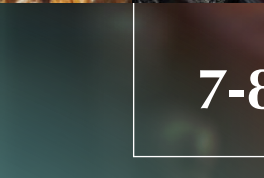

Corrina Hewat is one of Scotland's most distinctive harp players and singers. From the Highlands, with over 30 years as a composer and performer, she blends her own compositions with traditional Scottish songs and contemporary works to create soundscapes that shift between haunting and hopeful. Her music is dark, beautiful, infused with warmth and humour. Expect rich, resonant harp textures, songs and stories from a performer who deeply connects with her audience and the world around her.

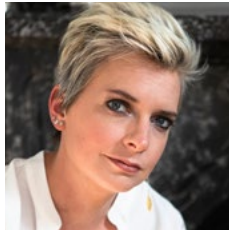

Catrin Finch

Catrin Finch, from Llanon on the west coast of Wales, is the most gifted classical harp virtuoso of her generation, grounded in prodigious early achievements and intense classical training, and serving as Royal Harpist to HRH The Prince of Wales in her early twenties. Catrin has performed with many of the world's leading orchestras; she has also achieved chart success with her number 1 rendition of Bach's Goldberg Variations, and has recorded for the world's leading classical labels. Catrin's boundless curiosity and adventurous spirit has led her into a parallel universe of musical success, most notably through her collaboration with kora virtuoso Seckou Keita with whom she won Best Group at the BBC Radio 2 Folk Awards 2019. In her classical career, Catrin Finch has performed with many of the world's leading orchestras, including the New York Philharmonic, the Royal Philharmonic, the Boston Pops, the Academy of St Martin in the Fields and the English Chamber Orchestra. She has graced the stages of A-list classical music festivals, including Salzburg, Edinburgh, Spoleto and MDR Musiksommer in Leipzig and toured throughout Europe, north and south America and the Middle East. Catrin has performed extensively throughout the USA, South America, the Middle East, Asia, Australia and Europe, both as a soloist, and appearing with many of the world's top orchestras, and has recorded for many of the major international recording companies, including Universal Records, Deutsche Grammophon, EMI and Sony Classical, both solo and with notable artists such as Bryn Terfel, Sir James Galway and Julian Lloyd-Webber. A versatile, fearless and ground-breaking artist, Catrin continues to explore and push the boundaries of her art with award-winning international collaborations with artists such as kora maestros Seckou Keita (Senegal) and Toumani Diabaté (Mali), Colombian joropo cowboy virtuosos Cimarron, and most recently Ireland's renowned classical violinist Aoife Ní Bhriain. Catrin is currently Head of Harp at The Royal Academy of Music, London.



Catrin Finch, sy'n hanu o Lanon ar arfordir gorllewinol Cymru yw'r delynores glasurol fwyaf hyfedr a dawnsu ei chenhedlaeth. Gyda gorchestion cynnar aruthrol a hyfforddiant clasurol dwys yn sail iddi, bu'n gwasanaethu fel Telynores Frenhinol Ei Uchelder Brenhinol Tywysog Cymru yn ei hugeiniau cynnar. Mae Catrin wedi perfformio gyda llawer o brif gerddorfeidd y byd; mae hi hefyd wedi cael llwyddiant yn y siartiau gyda'i pherfformiad rhif 1 o Amrywiadau Goldberg Bach, a mae recordio ar gyfer labeli clasurol mwyaf blaenllaw'r byd. Mae chwilyfrydedd di-ben-draw ac ysbryd anturus Catrin wedi ei harwain i fydsawd cyfochrog o lwyddiant cerddorol, yn fwyaf nodedig trwy ei chydweithrediad â'r pencampwr ar y kora Seckou Keita. Enillodd y ddau y wobr am y Grŵp Gorau yng Ngwobrau Gwerin BBC Radio 2 yn 2019. Yn ei gyrfa glasurol, mae Catrin Finch wedi perfformio gyda llawer o gerddorfeidd mwyaf blaenllaw'r byd, gan gynnwys Ffilharmonig Efrog Newydd, y Ffilharmonig Frenhinol, y Boston Pops, Academi St Martin in the Fields a Cherddorfa Siambur Lloegr. Mae hi wedi ymddangos ar lwyfannau brif wyliau cerddoriaeth glasurol y byd, gan gynnwys Salzburg, Caeredin, Spoleto a MDR Musiksommer yn Leipzig ac wedi teithio ledled Ewrop, gogledd a de America a'r Dwyrain Canol. Mae Catrin wedi perfformio'n helaeth ledled yr Unol Daleithiau, De America, y Dwyrain Canol, Asia, Awstralia ac Ewrop, fel unawdydd, a hefyd yn ymddangos gyda llawer o gerddorfeidd gorau'r byd, ac mae wedi recordio i lawer o brif gwmnïau recordio rhyngwladol, gan gynnwys Universal Records, Deutsche Grammophon, EMI a Sony Classical, yn unigol a gydag artistiaid nodedig fel Syr Bryn Terfel, Syr James Galway a Julian Lloyd-Webber. Mae Catrin, sy'n artist amryddawn, di-ôfn ac arloesol, yn parhau i archwilio a gwithio ffiniau ei chelf gyda chydweithrediaidau rhyngwladol gwobrwedig gydag artistiaid fel y meistri kora, Seckou Keita (Senegal) a Toumani Diabaté (Mali), a'r pencampwr joropo cowboi o Golombia, Cimarron, ac yn fwyaf diweddar, y feiolinydd clasurol enwog o Iwerddon, Aoife Ní Bhriain. Ar hyn o bryd, Catrin yw Pennaeth y Delyn yn yr Academi Gerdd Frenhinol, Llundain.

Corrina Hewat

Corrina Hewat is a renowned Scottish harper, singer and composer whose work bridges tradition and innovation. Rooted in the rich musical heritage of the Scottish Highlands, she spent her childhood on the Black Isle surrounded by music, art and storytelling—influences that continue to shape her introspective and expressive sound. Over a 30-year professional career, Corrina has become a leading figure in Scottish folk music. She directs the Scots folk choir Sangstream, co-founded DragonSong Productions, and contributed to Faber Music's Folk Tunes from the Women. A co-founder of The Unusual Suspects Big Band and Bachue (with David Milligan) and acclaimed vocal trios Shine, Grace, Hewat, Polwart, and Chantan, she continues to perform with Karine Polwart in Sing to the Dark. Corrina's music is known for its depth, warmth, and emotional honesty, and she is celebrated for her rare ability to bring out the best in others. Her most recent CD release is Song of Oak and Ivy. Wedi ei gwreiddio yn nhreftadaeth gerddorol Ucheldiroedd Yr Alban, treuliodd ei phlentynod ar y Black Isle wedi ei hamgylchynu gan gerddoriaeth, celf a dweud storïau - dylanwadau sy'n parhau i lunio ei sain fynegiannol a mewnblyg. Dros yrfa broffesiynol o 30 blynedd mae Corinna bellach yn ffigwr blaenllaw ym myd cerddoriaeth gwerin Albanaidd. Gwenllian Llŷr

Welsh harpist Gwenllian Llŷr is known for her charismatic and engaging performances. With prizes too numerous to list, including from the USA International Harp Competition and the Royal Over-Seas League Annual Music Competition, Gwenllian is becoming increasingly in demand as a solo performer. Following the successful release of her debut solo album, *Dusk to Dawn*, for which her playing was hailed as 'magnificent' and 'powerful', Gwenllian toured the UK both in concert venues and in the community as part of her work for the charity Live Music Now. She subsequently released a CD of Welsh music with Ty Cerdd, *Soliloquies for Harp*, including her own take on the quintessential Welsh hymn, *Calon Lan*. Both of Gwenllian's CDs are frequently featured on BBC Radio Cymru and BBC Radio 3, and her compositions have also been chosen for the ABRSM and Trinity examination lists. Gwenllian's passion for the harp knows no bounds: from her dedication to her students to the numerous harp pieces she has published, Gwenllian firmly believes in the power of music to bring people together. Yn dilyn llwyddiant ei halbwm unigol gyntaf, *Dusk to Dawn*, pan ddywedwyd 'rhagorol' a 'grymus' amdano, bu Gwenllian yn teithio yn y DU mewn neuaddau cyngerdd ac yn y gymuned fel rhan o'i gwaith ar gyfer yr elusen Live Music Now. Wedyn fe ryddhaodd CD o gerddoriaeth Gymreig gyda Ty Cerdd, *Soliloquies for Harp*, yn cynnwys ei fersiwn hi o'r emyn Cymraeg nodedig, *Calon Lan*. Clywir y ddwy CD gan Gwenllian ar BBC Radio Cymru a BBC Radio 3, a dewiswyd ei chyfansoddiadau ar gyfer rhestrau arholiad yr ABRSM a Trinity. Does dim terfyn ar angerdd Gwenllian o ran y delyn: o'i hymroddiad i'w myfyrrwyr, i'r darnau niferus i'r delyn mae hi wedi eu cyhoeddi, mae Gwenllian yn credu'n gryf yng ngrwm cerddoriaeth i ddod â phobl at ei gilydd. Tara Minton

Tara Minton is an Australian harpist, vocalist and composer. She is proudly endorsed by Les Harpes Camac and holds a master's degree in jazz performance from The Guildhall School of Music and Drama. Sought after as both a harpist and vocalist, Tara has worked with Björk, Stan Sulzmann, Geoff Gascoyne, Emma Rawicz, Alice Zawadski, Trish Clowes, Faris Ishaq, Ester Wiesnerova, The Ronnie Scott's All Stars, Opera North, The Royal Ballet and The Australian World Orchestra. Tara has released three records in the UK to great success: *The Tides of Love* (2016), *Please Do Not Ignore the Mermaid* (2020) and *Two for the Road* (2022). Tara's new record, *The Devil Invites You to Dance* is due for release on 13 February, 2026. Tara is joined by double bassist John Williamson for her concert.

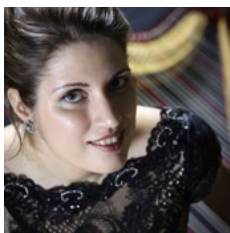

Veronika Lemishenko

Veronika Lemishenko is an international harpist from Ukraine, a member of the board of directors of the World Harp Congress, art-director of the 'Glowing Harp' competition and festival, and a member of the board of the European Union of Musical Competitions for Youth (EMCY). She is a principal harpist of the Croatian National Theatre in Osijek (Croatia) and a visiting tutor of the harp department at the Royal Birmingham Conservatoire. Born in Kharkiv, Ukraine, Veronika graduated from Kharkiv State Musical Lyceum with Professor Larysa Klievtsova; Gnesin Academy of Music (Russia) with Professor Milda Agazarian; Instituto di Musica Antica (Italy) with Professor Mara Galassi; and National University of the Arts (Argentina) with Professors Oscar Rodriguez do Campo and Mara Diniello. Veronika was a prizewinner at international harp competitions in Wales, France, Spain, Ukraine, Czech Republic, Bulgaria, Russia, Greece and Singapore. Veronika was guest artist of the international musical festivals 'La Folle Journee' and Camac Festival in France, 'HarpMasters Festspiele' in Switzerland, 'Vienna Harp Days' and 'Arpa GRAZiosa' in Austria, 'Lisboa Harp Seminar' in Portugal, 'Arpa Viggianes' in Italy and 'Midwest TN Harpfest' in the USA. Together with internationally-renowned German harpist, Florence Sitruk, Veronika is running 'Ukrainian Harp Festival - In Exile' and is co-founder of the 'Veronika Lemishenko Charity Foundation': since February 2022 all funds go to support Ukraine.
